Currently, the CJCCs PGSL (<http://cjcc.wa.cricket.com.au/>) rules do not align per age group with national junior formats, should this change the Junior formats should be the delineation, based on the batting restrictions:

Format	Batting Restrictions (non-20 innings matches)
JF St 1	Faces 17 balls regardless of dismissals - strike change after dismissal
JF St2	Dismissal is end of innings, retire at max. 35 balls, can return
JF St3	Dismissal is end of innings, retire at max. 60 balls, can return
